

THE STATE OF THE UNION: MENTAL HEALTH + ADDICTIONS IN THE US

The latest research shows that society's increasing dependence on screens, coupled with the ongoing pressure of social media and other social stressors, has contributed to declining mental health and well-being and rising rates of suicide in the US. Among the 61.5 million American adults with a mental health condition in the past year, 21.2 million also had a substance use disorder. This is even more dangerous because our country faces an illicit drug supply that is more toxic and unpredictable than ever.







MENTAL HEALTH CLINICAL OUTCOMES

Odyssey measures treatment outcomes for mental health and substance use disorders using the BASIS-24 across its programs, including Clearview Treatment Programs, Lifeskills Behavioral Health, Pasadena Villa Psychiatric Treatment Network, and STR Behavioral Health. To further expand the evaluation of program impact, Odyssey has incorporated the Brief Psychiatric Rating Scale (BPRS) and looks forward to sharing these results in future reports.

In addition, Lifeskills utilizes a comprehensive battery of assessment tools to measure behavioral and functional changes, supported by multi-year longitudinal studies that track client progress over time. Learn more at LifeskillsBH.com/outcomes.



2024 SYMPTOM REDUCTION | RESIDENTIAL SERVICES (BASIS-24)


A tool designed to assess the outcome of mental health or substance abuse treatment from the client's perspective. The results below show a reduction in average symptom severity.






2024 SYMPTOM REDUCTION | OUTPATIENT SERVICES (BASIS-24)





CLEARVIEW TREATMENT PROGRAMS (BASIS-24)


Overall Symptom Reduction







LIFESKILLS BEHAVIORAL HEALTH (BASIS-24)



METHODOLOGY + ASSESSMENT TOOLS

BASIS-24 Assessment

Our facilities utilize the BASIS-24, a leading behavioral assessment tool designed to measure a broad range of symptoms and challenges across the diagnostic spectrum. The instrument includes 24 questions rated on a five-point Likert scale and scored using a weighted average algorithm to generate both an overall score and six subscale scores. These subscales assess key domains: depression, relationships, self-harm, emotional lability, psychosis, and substance abuse. The questionnaire is administered at admission, mid-treatment (or every 30 days), and again at discharge to evaluate progress and treatment effectiveness over time.


Additionally, Lifeskills Behavioral Health includes several additional assessments, including the Difficulties in Emotional Regulation Scale (DERS), Brief Psychiatric Rating Scale (BPRS), Drug Attitude Inventory (DAI), and the Short Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder Rating Interview (SPRINT) to better understand impact and guide program development.


