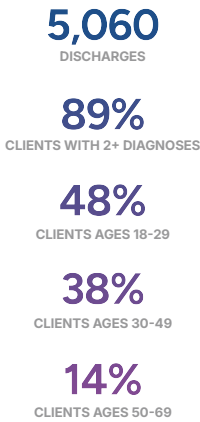

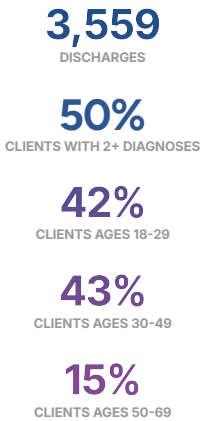

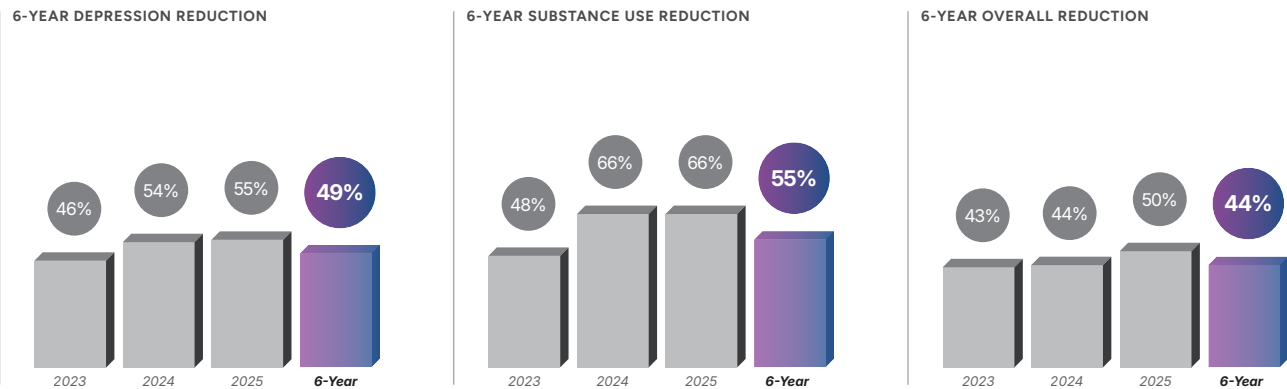
THE VALUE OF LONGITUDINAL DATA

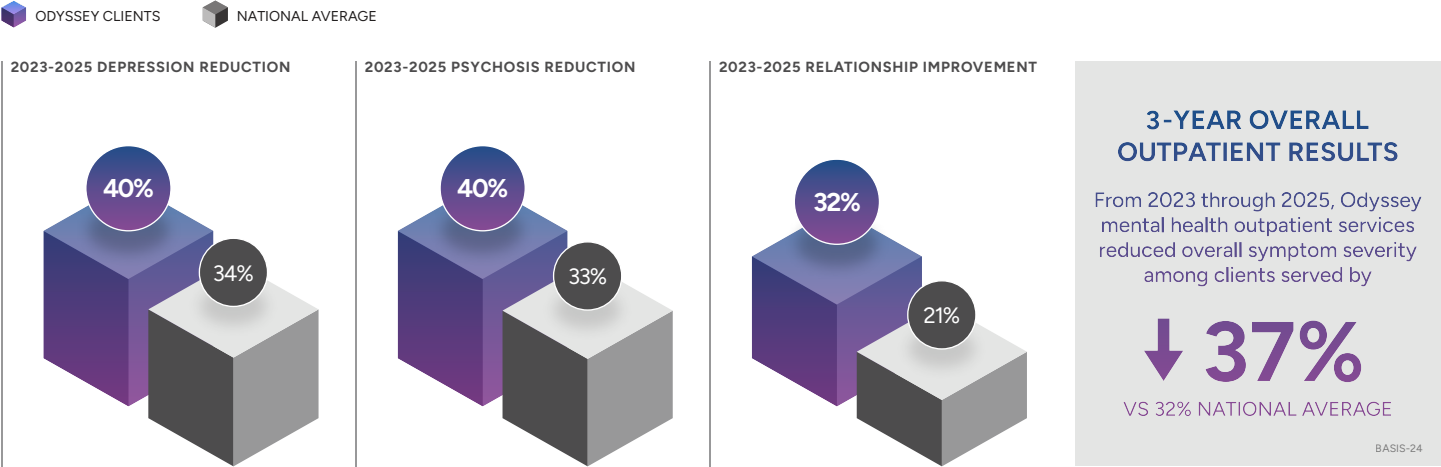


MENTAL HEALTH CLINICAL OUTCOMES

Odyssey measures treatment outcomes for mental health and substance use disorders using the BASIS-24 across its programs, including Clearview Treatment Programs, Lifeskills Behavioral Health, Pasadena Villa Psychiatric Treatment Network, and STR Behavioral Health. To further expand the evaluation of program impact, Odyssey has incorporated the Brief Psychiatric Rating Scale (BPRS) and looks forward to sharing these results in future reports.

In addition, Lifeskills utilizes a comprehensive battery of assessment tools to measure behavioral and functional changes, supported by multi-year longitudinal studies that track client progress over time. Learn more at LifeskillsBH.com/outcomes.

The BASIS-24 is a validated self-report instrument used to measure the outcomes of mental health and substance use treatment from the client's perspective. The results below show a reduction in average symptom severity.

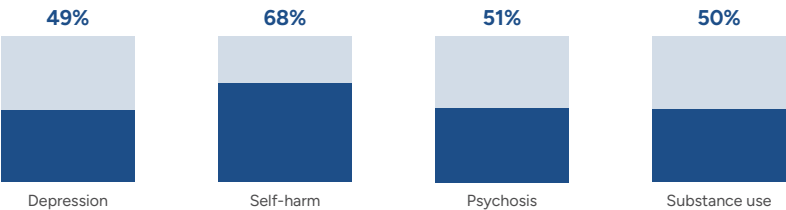
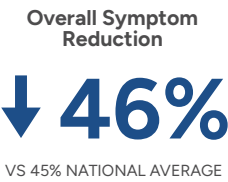
CLEARVIEW TREATMENT PROGRAMS (BASIS-24)



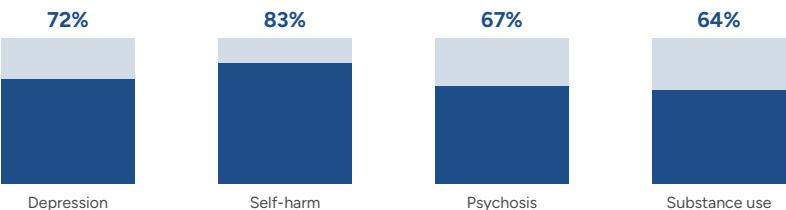
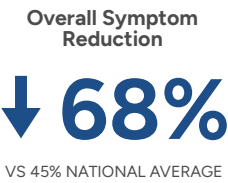
LIFESKILLS BEHAVIORAL HEALTH (BASIS-24)

MEASURING POST-TRAUMATIC GROWTH IN VETERANS + FIRST RESPONDERS

In 2025, STR Behavioral Health launched Overwatch, a specialized mental health program for first responders and veterans that combines culturally competent care with a post-traumatic growth framework to support long-term recovery. The program also integrated the Post-Traumatic Growth Inventory (PTGI), a validated assessment that measures self-reported growth, not symptom reduction, across five domains following trauma.

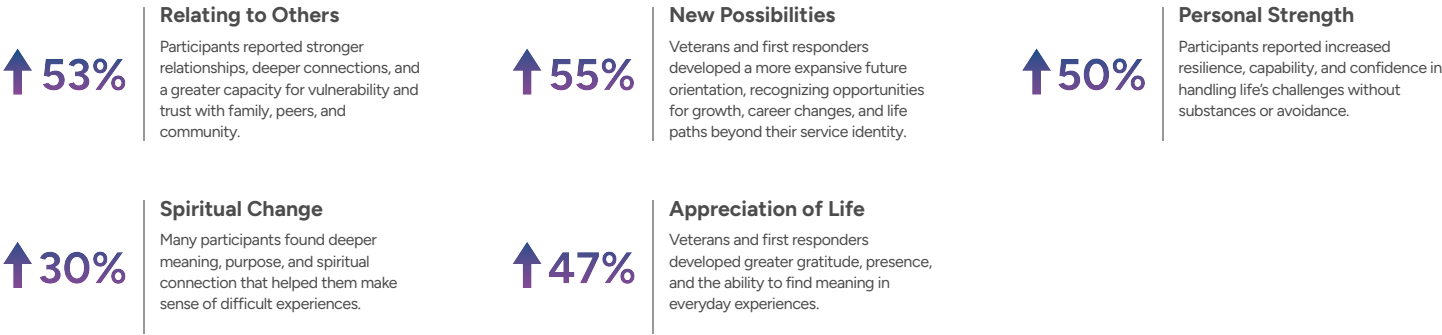
SELF-HARM REDUCTION

Among 31 participants with complete data, average scores rose from 77 at admission to 185 at discharge across core domains — an improvement of

GROWTH ACROSS ALL 5 DOMAINS

What makes these veterans’ mental health outcomes particularly meaningful is that improvement occurred across all five measured domains, indicating comprehensive — rather than isolated — change.



*Overwatch launched in 2025 and reflects an early cohort of 31 participants with complete data. As the program scales, outcomes will be updated to reflect a larger and more representative sample.

METHODOLOGY + ASSESSMENT TOOLS

BASIS-24 ASSESSMENT

Our facilities utilize the BASIS-24, a leading behavioral assessment tool designed to measure a broad range of symptoms and challenges across the diagnostic spectrum. The instrument includes 24 questions rated on a 5-point Likert scale and scored using a weighted average algorithm to generate both an overall score and 6 subscale scores. These subscales assess key domains: depression, relationships, self-harm, emotional lability, psychosis, and substance abuse. The questionnaire is administered at admission, mid-treatment (or every 30 days), and again at discharge to evaluate progress and treatment effectiveness over time.

Additionally, Lifeskills Behavioral Health includes several assessments — the Difficulties in Emotional Regulation Scale (DERS), Brief Psychiatric Rating Scale (BPRS), Drug Attitude Inventory (DAI), and the Short Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder Rating Interview (SPRINT) — to better understand impact and guide program development.

TRANSFORMATIVE PROGRAMS, MEASURABLE IMPACT

As part of Odyssey Behavioral Healthcare, our facilities deliver individualized care for mental health and substance use disorders. Across the network, the programs address co-occurring conditions and serve adults of all genders, with the specific populations and conditions treated detailed in each facility's program information.

INSURANCE + PAYMENT

Odyssey's facilities partner with most major insurance providers to offer coverage for mental health and substance use treatment. Several programs also accept private pay and out-of-network benefits. Each client works directly with the admissions team to build a financial plan that fits both their clinical needs and financial circumstances.
